We, Grand Chief Glenn Hudson, and I met at around 11:00 AM at the first white house at the entrance of the Peguis Community.

We inspected the house. A mold smell was appreciated. A visual inspection detected some black mold spots on the first floor and a lot in the basement. The mold smell was stronger (5 on a scale of 1 to 10) in the basement. We believe our product does the job, judging by smell appreciation.

### Work performed:

11:10 – 12:15 Sweep the floor of the first floor.

12:15 - 14:24 Sweep the basement and collect 2 pails of water from seepage on the west wall. A bottle with a water sample was taken.

This was in preparation for spraying Stamp Out.

14:30 Mold samples taken with masking tape. B1, B2, B, B4.

15:12 – 15:57 Spraying started in the basement. 24 liters. There was a very strong mold smell after the application in the west wall. 10 on a scale of 1 to 10.

16:10 – 15:38 Spraying on the first floor, 20 liters. Sweeping the floor, 4 liters.

The floor was swept. Left 2 boxes (8 bottles) to be used on the next application (Saturday June 1st).

4 liters to seep the floor.



## CONCLUSIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. To fix seepage from outside the west wall. Seal or French drainage is suggested.
2. There is a leakage from the pipe going out in the west wall that needs to be fixed.
3. Must be kept dry the floor on the west wall, all the time.
4. Replace the damaged insulation on the east wall, damaged by mice.
5. The HVAC is in excellent new condition.
6. The supporting west pole is rusted. To be aware of.
7. Some woods show mold infection.
8. I will ask Dr, Oule to analyze the samples taken.
9. Survey mold smell by Thursday, May 30<sup>th</sup>, and record smell appreciation (1 to 10).
10. Next full application by Saturday, June 1<sup>st</sup>.
11. Survey and record smell appreciation by June 8<sup>th</sup> (scale 1 to 10).
12. 3<sup>rd</sup> application by Saturday, June 8<sup>th</sup>.
